MDMCS under took a campaign to have our parcel of land excluded from the sale, this campaign comprised written petitions, protest rallies with cars trailer and bikes touring around the roads of Ingleburn (residence of the local member) which also attracted media publicity.

Eventually two Club committee members were summoned to meet senior government officials in their office tower in Sydney, to explain our position, result of this meeting the Club were granted permission to purchase the land under strict conditions, some of these were only Macarthur could purchase, no third party, price as set by the government, three month time period.
